Daniel Wittwer, from Linden (BE) and Zofingen, finished his studies in economics with a focus on economics and political science by obtaining his degree from the University of Bern in 1990. Between 2008 and 2010, he completed his training with an Executive MBA from the University of Zurich. After working as a policy analyst for the Federal Statistical Office for three years, in 1994, he moved for five years to a consultancy firm for nature, environmental and landscape protection with a focus on nature conservation economics. At the beginning of 1999, he joined the Swiss Communes Issuance Centre (ESG), initially as authorised signatory and as Deputy Director from 2001. At the start of 2010, he became Head of the Treasury Section (front office) of the Federal Finance Administration (FFA) and, one year later, became Deputy Head of the Federal Treasury Division. Since April 2015, Daniel Wittwer has been responsible for managing the Federal Treasury in a jobshare with Urs Eggenberger. In this function, he also represents the interests of the FFA on the Foundation Board of the LOB Guarantee Fund. He lives in Bern.
