

Sabine D'Amelio-Favez, Director



Sabine D'Amelio-Favez, from Penthéréaz (VD) and Massagno (TI), studied law at the University of Fribourg and Complutense University of Madrid from 1993 to 1999. She was admitted to the bar in the canton of Bern in 2001. From 2001, she worked as a specialist adviser for financial markets in the Secretariat of the Competition Commission and dealt with competition restraints in the areas of banking, insurance and payment transactions. In 2007, Sabine D'Amelio-Favez joined the Federal Audit Oversight Authority (FAOA) as Deputy Head of Legal and International Affairs. Following a part-time course, she obtained a Certificate in Advanced Studies in Business Administration for specialists and executives from Bern University of Applied Sciences (BFH) in 2015. As Vice Director, Sabine D'Amelio-Favez headed the Legal Services Division of the Federal Finance Administration (FFA) from 2016. The Federal Council appointed Sabine D'Amelio-Favez as Director of the FFA in 2020, and she took up office on 1 February 2021. She is married, has two children and lives in Bremgarten bei Bern.
