Adjustments in the national model of financial statistics as of September 1, 2016

## Changes in the national FS Model

Since fiscal 2008, the current Harmonized Accounting Model for the Cantons and Municipalities (HAM2) has formed the basis for the national FS Model. The data prior to 2008 was recorded in accordance with the earlier HAM1, which was less detailed than the HAM2. The Financial Statistics Section makes data adjustments in order to enhance the consistency of the time series.

The adjustments listed below and in the appendix<sup>1</sup> are due to the revision of the HAM2 chart of accounts in December 2015, as well as corrections of methodology inconsistencies. Those corrections completed the corrections partly implemented as of September 2015. More detailed information on the adjustments made can be found in the technical note of September 24, 2015.2
