

## Ruben Uña, Vice Director



**Ruben Uña**, a Swiss-Spanish dual citizen, completed his degree in public policy at the University of St Gallen in 1998. He then worked for two years at PricewaterhouseCoopers in Zurich in auditing and consulting. From 2001, he worked at Coca-Cola Beverages AG in supply chain and asset controlling and transferred the entire asset accounting to SAP. In 2003, he joined the Federal Administration and was Head of Finance and Accounting. Five years later, he became Head of Finance and Economic Affairs at the FDHA. In 2014, Ruben Uña moved to the FDF and became Head of Human Resources and Budgeting at the FOPER. At the beginning of 2018, he took over as Deputy Head of Finance at the FDFA's Directorate for Resources. In 2022, he was appointed Assistant Director General and Head of Finance at the FDFA. Ruben Uña has headed the Federal Finance and Accounting Division of the Federal Finance Administration as Vice Director since May 2025. He is married, has a grown-up son and lives in Wohlen near Bern.
