Adrian Martínez, Swiss-Spanish dual citizen, studied economics and business administration at the University of Bern and the Helsinki School of Economics, and graduated from the University of Bern (lic. rer. oec.) in 2006. He then worked for two years as a corporate client adviser at UBS in Bern and Zurich. In 2008, he joined the Fiscal Policy, Fiscal Equalization, Financial Statistics Division of the Federal Finance Administration, where he focused primarily on the implementation of the debt brake in the budget process and federal receipt estimates. He moved to the Federal Treasury Division of the Federal Finance Administration in 2018 and became Head of the Treasury Front Office Section. Adrian Martínez has been Vice Director of the Federal Treasury Division since the start of 2025. In this role, he also represents the interests of the Federal Finance Administration on the Board of Directors of compenswiss and on the Investment Committee of the Decommissioning Fund and Waste Disposal Fund for Nuclear Installations.
